



SIF Association Third Party Certification Agreement

THE PARTIES TO THIS AGREEMENT ARE:

- (1), a company incorporated in with a place of business at, as a Certifying Organization, and
- (2), a company incorporated in with a place of business at, as a Non-Certifying Organization.

WHEREAS:

- (A) The SIF Association is the proprietor or exclusive licensor of certain Trademarks.
- (B) The Certifying Organization wishes to certify the Non-Certifying Organization's SIF Enabled Application or Zone Integration Server.
- (C) The SIF Association is willing to permit the Certifying Organization to Certify as aforesaid, subject to the provisions of this Agreement.

THE PARTIES THEREFORE AGREE as follows:

1. Definitions

In this Agreement the following words shall have the following meaning unless the context otherwise requires:

Certifying Organization

In relation to any company referred to in this Agreement, Certifying Organization shall mean:

- a. Its holding company, and
- b. Any of its subsidiaries, and
- c. Any subsidiary of its holding company, and
- d. An organization desiring to certify a SIF Enabled Application that does not hold the license for the said product.

Non-Certifying Organization

In relation to any company referred to in this Agreement, Non-Certifying Organization shall mean:

- a. Its holding company, and
- b. Any of its subsidiaries, and
- c. Any subsidiary of its holding company, and
- d. An organization that owns a product license for a SIF Enabled Application; however, does not desire to certify said product.

Certification Policy

The certification policy for the SIF Certification Program, as modified by the SIF Association from time to time at its sole discretion, and set forth at <http://certification.sifassociation.org> or such additional or replacement locations as provided by the SIF Association.

Certified Product

Any product or service which has been certified in accordance with the Certification Policy and which remains a Certified Product as defined in the Certification Policy.

2. Terms

- 2.1. The Certifying Organization must sign and adhere to all terms and conditions outlined in the SIF Association's Trademark Licensing Agreement.
- 2.2. The Certifying Organization must adhere to all policies outlined in the Certification Policy.
- 2.3. If a SIF Association Member, the Non-Certifying Organization may use the SIF Certification marks in their promotional material under the condition that they agree to the terms outlined in the SIF Association Trademark License Agreement (TMLA) and sign the TMLA.
- 2.4. The Non-Certifying Organization may not use any of the Association's registered trademarks unless it is a member of the Association.
- 2.5. Appendix A must be printed out and signed on the Non-Certifying Organization's letterhead.
- 2.6. The Certifying Organization must pay all fees for the SIF Certification Program.
- 2.7. The Certifying Organization becomes the official Certification Program point of contact and abides by all rules and governance established in the SIF Certification Program.
- 2.8. The Non-Certifying Organization must supply the Certifying Organization all information required to complete the SIF Certification Program.
- 2.9. The Certifying Organization must upload a signed copy of this form and Appendix A as part of the certification registration in the web certification system.
